Treatment for Cancer

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

Radiotherapy uses a machine to send rays into your body to try and make the change go away. You lie very still on a bed whilst this is happening



Chemotherapy is a type of medicine which may help take away or make the cancer lump smaller. You will either have it as a tablet or in an injection



You may feel poorly after having chemotherapy or radiotherapy

Having any treatment should make you feel better. You may feel worried about having it

You can take a friend with you when you go for your treatment and they will be able to stay with you.
