

Easy Read


Easy read is a kind of accessible information - like large print, braille and audio.

3 Main things

- √ Make words easier.
- ✓ Use pictures alongside words.
- √ Keep document length short.




Some things to try

- ✓ Letters.
- √ Health information.
- ✓ Appointment cards.



Top Tips to get you started...



Use easy words

- ✓ Think of easy words that people use all the time.
- ✓ If you must use a hard word, explain what it means.



Keep sentences short


✓ Aim for 15 words or less per sentence.

✓ No more than 4 sentences in each paragraph.

✓ Start sentences with and, but and or if it helps break up the text.

Fonts

- ✓ Use a sans serif font like Arial, Helvetica or Frutiger.
- ✓ Main text should be at least 16pt.



Pictures

✓ Use pictures that match the words.

✓ Put pictures together to explain more ideas.

X Don't just place pictures randomly.



Layout



- ✓ Put pictures on the left and words on the right.
- √ Leave white space.
- ✓ You need a good reason to have more than 1000 words.
