







### waiting room

### The stethoscope checks your heart beat



#### The band gets loose and it is taken off









#### Having a blood test

### The nurse will ask you to put your arm out








nurse

# The blood will go into the syringe and then the nurse will take the needle out of your arm



# The band will be taken off and then you will be asked to press cotton wool on your arm



### The nurse may put a plaster on your arm






Plaster

An injection is a way of giving medication, often in your arm






Medication

### The nurse puts the medication into the syringe and then injects it into your arm






injection

### The needle is taken out of your arm




### The nurse puts a plaster on your arm

### This is what the nurse uses to look in your ears.






The nurse looks into your ears to see if you have any problems with your hearing.



If you have a problem the nurse will tell the doctor. They will then talk about any treatment.


