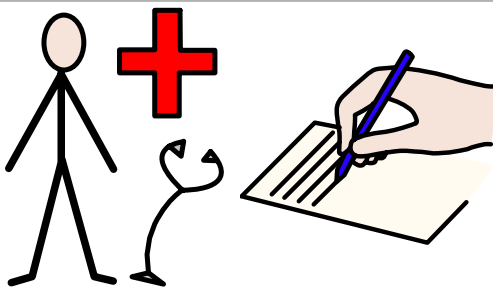
Information for patients



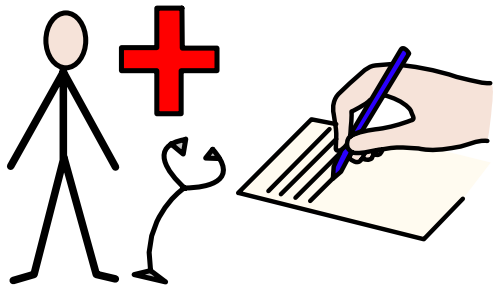
Section 17 of the Mental Health Act says that the Doctor will tell you when you can go out from the hospital.



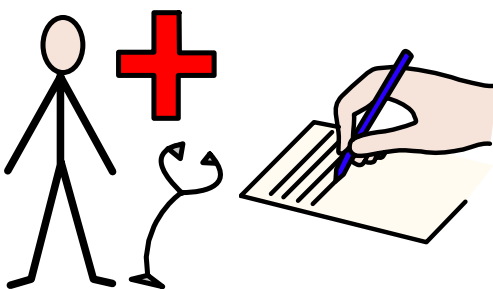
This is because you are on Section 2, Section 3, or Section 37 of the Mental Health Act.



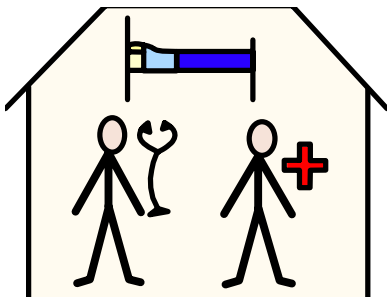
The Doctor will say and write who goes with you.



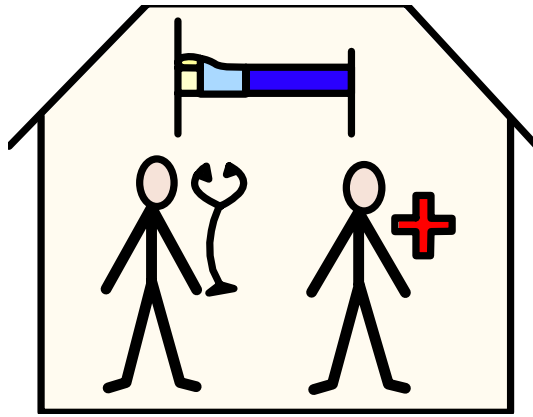
The Doctor will say and write where you go.



The Doctor will say and write what time you can go and what time you **MUST** come back.



If there are any concerns when you are out of the hospital you will be brought back.



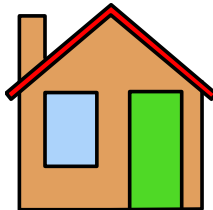

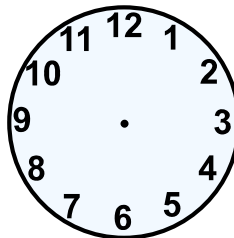
