


Section 2 of the Mental Health
Act says that 2 Doctors and a
Social Worker have agreed you
MUST stay here.




You <u>MUST</u> stay for up to 28 days so that Doctors can help you.



If you go before 28 days without the Doctor saying Nurses will bring you back.



After 28 days the Doctor will write to say if you go or stay.



Remember - if you think you can go before 28 days - talk or write to the Hospital Managers or your Doctor.



You can also write to the Mental Health Review Tribunal before 14 days and they will arrange a review.



The Tribunal is 3 people from outside the hospital. You can either have a Solicitor and/or advocate to speak for you.
