## Your First Visit



When you arrive, you will be welcomed by the receptionist.



You will wait in the waiting room. If you find waiting difficult, phone us and let us know before your appointment.



You will meet the dentist and the nurse. The dentist will ask you to sit in the chair.





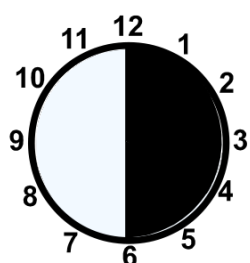
If you have a wheelchair, you can stay sitting in it for your treatment. We will tip it back slowly.



The dentist may take x-rays of your teeth. This will show how healthy your teeth are.



We will not usually do fillings or any other treatment during your first appointment.



The appointment will last about 30 minutes.



**How to find us:**

**Come to the North Wing.**

**Use entrance N1. This is the main entrance where the buses stop.**

**Turn right after you go inside.**

**There are disabled parking spaces outside the North Wing.**
