
Some women are worried about using tampons.

urethra wee comes out of here


A tampon will soak up the blood from your period.

Always take the tampon out before you put a new one in.

It is very important to take the last tampon out at the end of your period.

It is important to change your tampon about every 4 hours. Never keep a tampon in for more than 8 hours.
